Supports local companies to develop the skills and competencies needed to participate in New Jersey's growing offshore wind (OSW) industry



An OSW advisory and certification company will help participating NJ small- and medium-sized businesses:

- Assess their current capacity to supply the OSW market
- Develop an action plan to get up to the current industry standards



- 75% of program cost will be covered
- Proposal anticipates that participating companies will be responsible for a portion of the cost to ensure their commitment to full participation and completion of the program



Companies that complete the program will be independently certified with industry credentials that are important for securing contracts.
