SUPPORT LETTER FOR MERCER COUNTY APPLICATION TO US DOT'S RECONNECTING COMMUNITIES PILOT PROGRAM

Chair Povia requested that Ms. Esser, Director, Governance, EDA summarize the item before the board.

Ms. Esser stated that the Members' approval was requested to submit, in substantially final form, a letter in support of Mercer County's Application to U.S. Department of Transportation's Reconnecting Communities Pilot Program, consistent with the goals of the CCRC Renaissance Plan. A motion to approve was made by Mr. Laurenti, seconded by Mr. Cimino, and approved by a unanimous vote.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mr. Robert Tessier, DCA stated that he supported what the CCRC and other entities were doing in this regard to support redevelopment of Route 29.

Mayor Gusciora stated that the City of Trenton wholeheartedly supports this action.

Ms. Povia stated that she received advice from a long-time planner to never take the Boulevard off of the table.

Ms. Reed stated that NJ Legislature deserves acknowledgement for passing legislation to create the CCRC.
